Description of Registration Statuses for NYS Attorneys

<u>CURRENTLY REGISTERED</u> – Attorney has met his/her obligation to file a biennial registration as required by Part 118 of the Rules of the Chief Administrator.

<u>Due To Re-Register within 30 days of Birthday</u> – Attorney is due to file a biennial registration within 30 days **after** his/her birthday as required by <u>Part 118</u> of the Rules of the Chief Administrator.

<u>DELINQUENT</u> – Attorney has failed to file one or more biennial registrations, and is subject for referral for disciplinary action by the Appellate Division, as required by <u>Part 118</u> of the Rules of the Chief Administrator.

<u>Suspended</u> – Attorney has been suspended from the practice of law in New York by the Appellate Division due to unethical conduct or the failure to comply with rules governing New York attorneys

<u>DISBARRED</u> – Attorney has been stricken from the roll of attorneys by order of the Appellate Division due to unethical conduct or the failure to comply with rules governing New York state attorneys.

<u>RESIGNED FROM BAR — DISCIPLINARY REASON</u> — Attorney with pending disciplinary proceedings was permitted, by order of the appellate division, to resign from the New York state bar.

<u>RESIGNED</u> - Attorney's request to voluntarily resign from the New York state bar for non-disciplinary reasons was granted by the Appellate Division.

DECEASED – Death of the attorney has been verified, or presumed based on age.

INCAPACITATED - Attorney's incapacity has been verified, or presumed based on age.
